
**PUBLIC HOLIDAY - FRIDAY 08TH JANUARY 2021 IN RESPECT OF LATE RIGHT HONORABLE

Following on from EFPNG Circular No.01-2021, we inform that the Federation has received a formal Gazettal Notice on the declaration of **Friday 8th January 2021 as a Public Holiday** throughout Papua New Guinea in honor of the Late Former Prime Minister, Sir Mekere Morauta.

The public holiday is declared by the instrument - National Gazette No. G5 dated 6th January 2021- a copy of which is hereby attached. Employers who will be engaging employees during the Public Holiday will be required to pay the applicable public holiday penalties.
