

**QUEEN'S BIRTHDAY PUBLIC HOLIDAY – MONDAY 14 JUNE 2021**

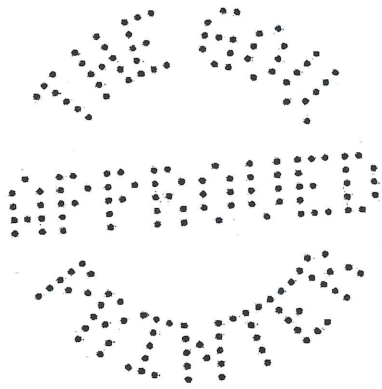

*Public Holiday Act (Chapter 321)*

## AMENDMENT TO THE NATIONAL PUBLIC HOLIDAYS FOR YEAR 2021

I, **JOB POMAT**, Acting Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the *Public Holidays Act* (Chapter 321) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby:—

- (a) revoke Monday 7th June 2021 as a Public Holiday in 2021; and
- (b) declare Monday 14th June 2021 as a Public Holiday in 2021 to Commemorate Her Majesty, the Queen's Birthday; and
- (c) declare Monday, 27th December 2021, the next day after the Boxing Day as Public Holiday on Sunday, 26th December 2021, a Public Holiday.
